

Suggested wording to managers when asked to attend more than 30 minutes of meetings a week:

"I wanted to let you know in advance that I will only be able to attend 30 minutes of the meeting scheduled for next week. The college faculty bargaining team and OPSEU have been clear about the scope of the current stage of its work to rule campaign, and has clearly communicated that its members will not be performing tasks outside of the strict letter of the requirements of their SWFs – as a result, such tasks are considered 'struck work' and the performance of such work is analogous to the crossing of a 'picket line'. I believe the work we do in this committee is valuable and important to the continuation and development of students and the quality of education. In this regard I take my role as a committee member seriously and wanted to let you know in advance so you can plan accordingly."
